Purposes and legal basis of data processing:

Purposes: Property protection (burglary, theft, vandalism),
Personal protection (protection of physical integrity)
Exercise of domiciliary rights
Legal basis: Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f

legitimate interests pursued:

Deterrence of potential offenders
Prevention and prosecution of theft, vandalism and burglary
Entry and exit control
Securing/monitoring of hazardous areas

Storage period or criteria for determining the duration:

The stored recordings are regularly overwritten, and deletion takes place after 14 days at the latest, if no further storage is necessary to preserve evidence. When this processing purpose ceases to apply, the data will be deleted.

Recipients or categories of recipients of the data:

The data is only processed internally at Gremmler Bauchemie GmbH, if it is not requested by law enforcement authorities.

References to the rights of the data subjects

The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation from the controller as to whether personal data concerning him or her is being processed; if this is the case, they have a right to information about this personal data and to the information listed in detail in Art. 15 GDPR. The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her and, if necessary, the completion of incomplete personal data (Art. 16 GDPR).

The data subject has the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay, provided that one of the reasons listed in detail in Art. 17 GDPR applies, e.g. if the data is no longer needed for the purposes pursued (right to erasure). The data subject has the right to demand from the controller the restriction of processing if one of the conditions listed in Art. 18 GDPR is met, e.g. if the data subject has objected to the processing, for the duration of the review by the controller.

The data subject has the right to object, at any time, to the processing of personal data concerning him or her, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation. The controller then no longer processes the personal data unless it can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for the processing that outweigh the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject, or the processing serves to assert, exercise or defend legal claims (Art. 21 GDPR).

Every data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data concerning him or her infringes the GDPR (Art. 77 GDPR). The data subject may invoke this right before a supervisory authority in the Member State of his or her residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement.
